Lobbying Governments:

Engaging legislators and officials to secure state adoption of the proposed treaty at the international level.



UN General Assembly:

Supporting adopting states in advancing the treaty's proceedings at the UN General Assembly.



Global Monitor:

Creating an independent global mechanism to document and expose all violations of the proposed treaty.


Work in Accelerating Progress
